Converting Domain Naming Terminology into a User Friendly Name

A custom created domain in JasperReports Server uses database views and tables from the RiskVision database. Further, if you customize the display name of an object, or if a custom attribute is added to any RiskVision object, such attributes will fail to render the display names from the user interface of that object when you create a domain. As a result, all the attributes in a domain have names that are not easy to understand while creating a report. In order to help you pick the correct attributes while creating an Ad-Hoc report, provides an utility that can import a resource bundle of a particular domain to fully convert the customized attribute naming terminology into a userfriendly name. When you convert a particular JasperReports domain, all the attribute names matches with the attributes present in RiskVision.

A domain naming terminology can be converted into a user-friendly name using a three-step procedure:

- 1. Exporting a Domain Resource Bundle
- 2. Importing a Domain Resource Bundle into RiskVision
- 3. Adding a New Resource Bundle

Before you start the conversion process, make sure that your RiskVision role has the **Configure UI** permission, and also you have the administrator role for the JasperReports Server.
